Trailer Race - \$600 to win-350-200-150-125-100-75-50 to start **Rules:** All small flatbed trailers will have an appliance, a couch, a porta-jon, a 55-gallon drum full of water, a dining room table & chairs, a fully lit Christmas tree, fully clothed mannequins or something similar strapped on your trailer. If you lose your trailer or most of your load, you are out of that race. So, tie it on tight! All participants will need their trailer rig as well as a fully equipped trailer. KS may have a few trailers for sale cheap if needed.

Compact FWD Stock Demo Derby - \$500 to win-250-100-75-50 to start **Rules:** All compact FWD cars or mini vans. No cheated-up cars with steel channel or equivalent all over the body. No Bobcat or solid tires allowed. Have a safe car...not a cheated-up car.

SUV Spectator Drags – \$250 to win-\$100 runner up . Street Legal Trucks or SUV's Only Limited to the first 16 participants.
