RESERVED SEATING is located on the large deck in Turn 3. Your individual seat, with room to walk around, will be waiting for you whether you arrive at 4 PM for qualifying or 7 PM just in time to catch the racing action. Complimentary refreshments such as fruit, veggies, chips, dip, cookies, bottled water and sodas will be available from 5:00 - 9:00 PM. A cash-only adult beverage station will be located adjacent to the deck entrance stocked with ice cold beer, wine and hard lemonades. Call the Speedway Office at (269) 692-2423 to reserve seat(s) with either a credit or debit card. Any seats remaining on race day will be sold at the ticket windows.

The Klash is a **RESTRICTED COOLER EVENT**. Only 6-pack sized, soft-side coolers will be allowed into the grandstand area.

Anyone under the age of 18 must sign in with a parent or legal guardian (no exceptions) when purchasing a KLASH **PIT PASS**. Junior pit passes are available for youth 11 and under. (see pricing in chart)

Duco Performance "B" Feature Payout



\$1,000 to win. 600 - 500 - 450 - 400 - 350 - 330 to start.

(The "B' Feature winner may elect to start last in the "A" Feature, but will forfeit their "B" Feature pay).

Alliance Body Rules – Mufflers are Mandatory – 45" front & 46" rear overhang. 82" tread width measured outside to outside at the bottom of the tire. 72" body width at the rear - 76" width over rear tires - 82" wide over front tire. No body panels over 83" wide including the splitter or front fender flares. Maximum 3" fender flares not to extend out past the edge of the tire. Spoiler maximum 72"x 8" tall clear material with 1" lip - 42" off the ground. Spoiler supports to be ¾" round tubing. 60% left & 2700 lbs before qualifying & before the start of the race. Fox spec shock weight break of 50 lbs and 2% left side. No tire altering of any kind.

Setting the Kalamazoo Klash XXVI Field

Qualifying - The fastest 20 qualifiers will be locked into the race.

Position 21 - Kalamazoo Speedway Point Provisional: The highest driver in current Kalamazoo Speedway Outlaw Super Late Model point standings that does not qualify in the top 20, will start 21st. If no driver is eligible for this provisional, the position will not be filled.

Position 22 - If the "B" Feature winner elects to forfeit their "B" Feature pay, they may elect to start on the tail of the "A" Feature.

Inversion - The inversion for Kalamazoo Klash XXVI will be eight plus the roll of two dice. Essentially this will make the inversion between 10 and 20. The inversion for the "B" Feature will be the roll of one dice, making the inversion between one and six.

Kalamazoo Klash XXVI Race Format/Rules

- Due to the large expected car counts, all cars will be parked in the infield and all trucks and trailers will be removed from the infield. Bring your easy-ups, tarps and war wagons no trucks or trailers will be left in the infield.
- All teams will use the Hoosier D800 (\$480 a set) for qualifying and racing. All teams will start the race on the same 4 tires they used to qualify. No race tires may be purchased or reserved until Wednesday, August 8 at 10:00 AM. All tires must be purchased at the track.
- No mirrors. No traction control. RACEceivers are mandatory.
- The qualifying order will be the determined by the speeds in the final Kalamazoo Klash XXVI practice session. The slowest car in the final practice will qualify first, while the fastest car in the final practice session will qualify last. If a car does not compete in the final practice session it will be the first car to qualify. If multiple cars do not compete in the final practice their order will be determined by a blind draw. If any car does not qualify in the position in which they are scheduled, they will lose one lap of qualifying. If there is a tie in qualifying to the thousandth of a second, the tie breaker will be the car higher in the current Kalamazoo Speedway Outlaw Super Late Model point standings. If the tie is still not broken the next tie breaker will be the faster car from the final practice session. The final tie breaker will be a coin flip (2 drivers) or blind draw (3 or more drivers).
- 125 laps with no breaks. There will be a competition caution at lap 100. If there has been a caution after lap 75, the competition caution will not take place.
- The top eligible lapped car at each caution (including the competition caution) will receive the "Lucky Dog Free Pass". A car is not eligible to receive the Lucky Dog Free Pass when, in the judgment of the officials:
 - The car caused the caution;
 - The car was in the pit area when the caution came out; or,
 - The car has been penalized with a discretionary call. In the case of a discretionary penalty, it will be made known to the competitor, at the time the discretionary penalty is imposed, that the car will not be eligible to receive the Pass to make up the penalized lap(s). Transferring the Pass will only occur when the first eligible car becomes ineligible to receive the Pass because of a discretionary penalty, because the car pitted under the caution or because the first eligible car is not in competition at the time the yellow flag is displayed. Then the Pass will be transferred to the next eligible car. There will not be a lucky dog on a false start.
- For both features, all restarts will be double file. The leader will choose their lane and the second place car will fill the other position on the front row. Starting with 3rd place on back odd numbered positions will line up on the inside and even numbered positions will line up on the outside. In the event there is a car being sent to the tail, a lucky dog and a car coming out of the pits, they will be lined up in that order.
