Explanation & Objective of the NOD Events

Trailer Race – See **Trailer Race Rules** for the complete set of rules for this event. We are not looking for the Outlaw Professional Trailer Race Jockeys that have popped up over the years. If you've got more than two nights into preparing a Trailer Race Rig.....this deal at Kazoo is probably not for you! However, if you want to have fun & try to win a few dollars, this event will be a blast! And if you've brought a 50 lb. mini trailer to a trailer race before, that trailer won't cut it this time.

The objective of this race is easy..... finish the race with your trailer & its load still intact ahead of the other drivers and you win. But to greatly increase your odds of a good finish, the main objective of this event is to knock the trailers and/or the loads on your competitors' trailers, which eliminates from contention. No vehicle to vehicle hits....use your vehicle & hit your competitors trailers only! If you lose your trailer, you are done for this event.

Road Rage Drags – this one is kind of like a Spectator Drag event on steroids. Open to almost any vehicle, this bracket style of event is open to the first 16 vehicles. Two vehicles will start side by side in turn 1 and will race down the front stretch towards the big tire in turn 4. Get to the tire & go 180 degrees around the tire & race back to the finish line. Winner moves on to the next round & the loser will exit the track. The word "Road Rage" is open for interpretation.....but of course keep it safe & no head on or driver's door hits allowed!

Demo Derby's – See **Demo Derby Rules** for the complete list of what you can & cant do to your cars. If we get enough mini vans as well as compact FWD cars, we will run two mini derbies with two complete payouts. Again, we are not looking for the professional outlaw derby car with the steel channel, welded frames & steel cable inner woven throughout the car. We want safe cars & offer great entertainment to our 6000 spectators!! Just like the trailer race.....if you have over two days in preparing one of these cars, you've over built it!

Anything Goes Winner Take All FWD Compact Enduro – this one is going to be a fun one. The crowd will witness 20....25.....30....maybe even 35 cars & mini vans line up 6 or 7 wide at the start line & go for a maximum of a 15 lap Dash for the Cash!! **\$500 to win a 15 lap race**.....you have to wonder what the interpretation of "Anything Goes" will develop as these drivers sprint for the Cash!!
