## **Trailer Race Rules – 2018 NOD Events**

### **GENERAL Rules**

1. **Safety is #1.**
2. All personnel in pits (Drivers, Pit Crew and Others) must purchase a pit pass & sign waiver.
3. Full face helmet & fire suits are required. NO open toed shoes allowed in the pit area.
4. Shoulder and lap belts are required; racing harness is highly recommended.
5. Air bags must be removed.
6. No alcohol in the pit area will be allowed!

### **TOW VEHICLES**

1. Most Street legal vehicles may be used. NO Semi's or Outlaw Beefed Up Full Sized vehicles
2. No operational 4-Wheel drive vehicle. (If using a 4 x 4 you must remove front or rear driveshaft so 4 x 4 cannot work.)
3. Kalamazoo Speedway has the right to allow or disallow any vehicle for any event.
4. If tow vehicle is deemed inappropriate or unsafe to be on track, vehicle will not run.
5. All side glass must be removed or rolled down 100%. Windshield or rear window optional.
6. You may weld and or blot a steel door plate (highly recommended) over the driver's side doors.
7. You may have door bars on the inside or the exterior of the driver's door. All exterior bars or tubing must be 100% for safety & not for beefing up the car.
8. Driver's door must be chained or welded shut. All doors highly recommended to have chained or welded shut
9. Exterior lights removed.
10. All tow vehicles must have working brakes. No dually's allowed.
11. No solid filled tires. Must be DOT highway tires. This is for the tow vehicle & the trailer.
12. All tow vehicles & trailers will start out the race with no flat tires or plain wheels.
13. No added weight on tow vehicles.
14. Tow vehicle – No passengers and no changing of drivers allowed.
15. Not looking for a professional trailer race vehicle, this is a novelty race.

### **TRAILERS**

1. Tires must be on outside of frame rail. They cannot have any kind of protection around them.
2. **Minimum Trailer Size 4' wide by 8' long (tongue to rear of trailer) and must weigh a minimum of 300 lbs.**
3. All trailers must be hauling something significant. No blow up or plastic toys or figurines.
4. A small flatbed trailer must have a washer or TV or an equivalent appliance for the novelty of this race. All objects must be securely secured.
5. All trailers (campers, pop-ups, boats, utility, flat bed, etc.) must be approved by KS officials.
6. All camper holding tanks must be empty and drained. All propane or gas tanks must be removed.
7. Boat motors & excess trash in the back of trailers must be removed.
8. Hitches: Ball type or hitch pin type. No gooseneck trailers, no pintal hitches. Tongues of trailers CANNOT be made to spin around.

### **RACE RULES**

1. Object of race: Finish race with your trailer while attempting to separate the trailer of your competitors from their tow vehicle.
2. If you lose your trailer or the object your carrying during the race, you will be DQ'd and must exit the racing surface. (go into the pit area)
3. No tow vehicle to tow vehicle hits allowed. Must only hit trailers. Vehicle to vehicle hits will be DQ'd.
4. First vehicle to finish the race with eligible trailer or last vehicle with eligible trailer attached wins.
5. All decisions by judges/officials are final.
6. Most original best looking trailer contest pays \$100 bonus & start pole of the race!
