TOP 10: 2019 ZOO STOCK




Ordinarily we'd use this space to share a few photos from the festivities celebrating the achievements of our drivers in 2019, but the photographer who takes the newsletter pictures wasn't in attendance and we haven't been able to access other pictures. So we'll be improvising and publishing the posters that were given out (along with the usual hardware) to each Top 10 driver. As space permits we'll also include those not in the top 10 but who made it to every race in their class! We were able to get our hands on one photo from the Caribbean-themed award's night—Gary Howe and Cade West. West was one of the winners in the costume contest.

We'll start with the Top 10 in the Zoo Stock and we'll continue over the next several months until we get through the remaining 4 classes.

One driver short of 100 earned points in the Zoo Stocks in 2019. Eight drivers got caught up in the Zoo Stock speed limit and were promoted to the Outlaw FWDs. Mid-season the limit was changed and drivers could return to the Zoos if they desired. This gave Nick Failing the opportunity to graduate to the Outlaw FWDs a second time in one season. Grant Lofquist pulled off an 8th place finish despite his graduation and made the most of his Zoo Stock reinstatement by winning the feature the night of his return.

Dillon Rose rose (ha!) to the top 10 in quick form joining the season on June 21 and by August 2 he was in the 10th position in points, ultimately finishing 9th. Logan Hiemstra went home with 3rd place in the final standings and sporting a Most Improved Driver designation. Jared Blanchard in his first year of racing at Kalamazoo Speedway made an impression over the course of the season and also took home Most Improved Driver. Jorden Brinkert raced at Super Shoe in 2018 then ran his first full season at the Zoo this year taking Rookie of the Year honors. Brinkert led the point standings 4 times over the course of the season and held it going into championship night. Rookie Matt Elsey Jr. was the youngest driver at the Speedway this season; he won't be 15 until next year. He finished second in the 'B' feature on opening night and got the hang of racing quickly. Elsey Jr. was in 4th place (-20) going into championship night with a chance at the championship. He was 10 points down after qualifying. And then he exceeded the speed limit in the feature and finished 5th for the season. His dad joined him in the top 10 by finishing 10th. Rielly Meade held the point lead 4 times over the course of the season but didn't have the lead going into championship night. He captured the title despite being relegated to running in the 'B' feature one week, and like 3 of his colleagues, won the 'B'. His brother, Logan, finished 7th in the final standings, with a win on championship night in his first top 5 finish of the season.









RANDY SWEET

Randy Sweet passed away on Friday, November 8 at the age of 72, one week after being inducted into the Berlin Raceway Hall of Fame. In 2017, Sweet promoted the Sweet Manufacturing Outlaw Super Late Model Series to generate additional passion and drivers in the six marquee events that comprised the series. Kalamazoo Speedway hosted two of the six races. Sweet was no stranger to racing at Kalamazoo Speedway and last piloted a car at the track in 2017 driving a winged super sprint when the King of the Wing National Sprint Car series came to visit. The Call of the Wild was introduced in 2007 to challenge Randy Sweet's all time track (and world) record lap speed. The record had stood since 1982 at 10.746 seconds and his record didn't fall until 2008.

Our thoughts are with his family and his colleagues at Sweet Manufacturing.

RULES FOR 2020

The 2020 Rules are coming! Look for them soon on the Kalamazoo Speedway website. Among the changes, a section on chassis has been added to all RWD classes and additional base weights to the Outlaw FWD. The Street Stock rules (body) saw the most changes. Look



for 2019 tech bulletins (transponder pouches, Zoo Stock and Outlaw FWD tow hooks, tire soaking/altering penalties, driver changes, Zoo Stock lap times) to have been incorporated. Tighter definition of the Rookie of the Year has been made so that say, Tyler Roahrig, couldn't decide to run a season in the Street Stock and be Rookie of the Year.
