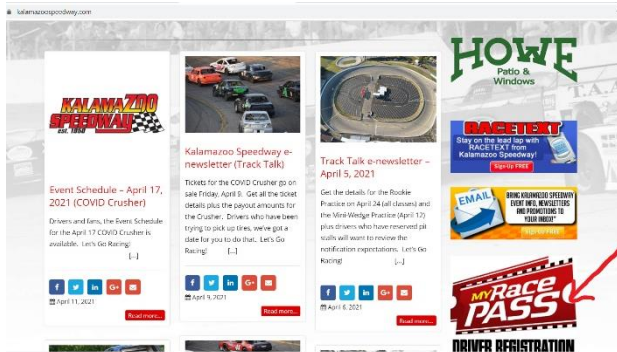


DRIVER REGISTRATION

Drivers, please register through MyRacePass before coming to the track for the first time this season. Registration must be completed prior to picking up your transponder.



Please visit the Kalamazoo Speedway homepage: www.kalamazoospeedway.com. On the right side of the site is an icon for MyRacePass. Click on the icon and you will be asked to create an account if you have not previously done so. Once you have an account, complete the registration form. This registration takes the place of the Driver Information Form that the Speedway has used for years. Registering ensures your car is scored when you are qualifying and racing. Thank you.

SAFETY REQUIREMENTS for the APRIL 16 PRACTICE & APRIL 17 COVID CRUSHER

Don't forget to bring a mask to any event you plan to attend at Kalamazoo Speedway for the foreseeable future. Masks must be worn by fans, drivers and Speedway personnel except when seated in the grandstands or when drivers and crews are within the driver's pit stall. Everyone must wear a mask when visiting concessions, restrooms, tire barn, transponder table, gift shop, ticket windows, finding a seat in the grandstands, etc. and maintain social distancing. Like you, we look forward to a time when these measures are no longer needed. Drivers inside of the vehicles proceeding to tech or the make ready chute can skip the mask; however, crew members accompanying them must be masked. Persons in the grandstands should maintain social distancing between groups who did not come to the track together. We thank you for your cooperation in keeping everyone safe.

Tickets for the Crusher will only be available at the ticket windows on race day if we have tickets remaining given the capacity limits established for us by the State of Michigan. We will post whether tickets will be available on race day via Facebook and our website. Persons who will be picking up the doubled tickets from the 2020 season may use all or some of those tickets for the Crusher. Several skyboxes remain for the Crusher. Seasonal and weekly skyboxes may also be purchased at this time.
