### **ROOKIE PRACTICE**



Kalamazoo Speedway is offering a practice session from 9:00 – 10:30 AM on Saturday, April 24 for rookies. There is no charge for this session. Upon arrival, enter through the pit gates and drive through the upper pits. If any driver is on the track practicing when you arrive, wait until the track is clear before entering the track to get to the infield.

This session is for true rookies. For the most part, these are kids (or adults) who have never raced before. It is not for drivers who, for instance, ran a Zoo Stock in 2019 and plan to move up a class this year. Rookie practice is an opportunity for aspiring drivers to get the feel of their car and the track without feeling conspicuous when they stall the car out or have to contend with experienced drivers swarming them while they take their first cautious laps around the track.

Please call (269) 355-4628 to let us know you are planning to attend so that we have ample staff on hand to provide direction and assistance. Drivers may elect to stay for the afternoon Open Practice; however, pit passes (\$20) are required for the afternoon session.

#### **RESERVED PIT STALLS**



Just a few reminders for drivers who have reserved pit stalls for 2021.

- Premier Events and Traveling Groups: Pit stalls will occasionally need to be altered for events such as the Klash or Winged Sprints.
- Off Weeks for Your Class: When your class is not scheduled to race, your pit stall may be used for another driver whose class is running. In the event you plan to use your reserved stall for another car that will be competing you must text or email Gary by Friday morning to let him know you plan to use the space.
- Not Competing When Your Class is on the Schedule: If you will not be racing on a night your class is scheduled to race you must contact Gary by Friday morning to let him know you will not be using the space. A no show/no call for a week when your class is on the schedule will result in your pit stall being given away for the next night your class is scheduled to race UNLESS you email or text Gary to tell him you WILL be using your pit stall for that week.

Our goals are simple. Drivers who have reserved a pit stall will have the space available on competition nights and drivers who don't have a reserved space will not have to pit in the weeds while pit stalls stand vacant. We thank you for your cooperation.
