



Kalamazoo, Michigan. In the make-ready chute is the Season Opener featuring all five of the Kalamazoo Speedway weekly classes. A staple of the Opener is the Intimidator 100 for the Outlaw Super Late Models. After a soggy Saturday, the final open practice was moved to April 27. Kalamazoo Speedway hosted drivers tuning up their cars one last time before the Season Opener. Dillon Rose claimed fast time in the Zoo Stock with a lap time of 16.662 seconds. Dave Leonard, Jr. drove to a time of 15.40 in the Outlaw FWD class. In the Street Stock it was Matt Weenick driving to the top with a time of 15.16 seconds. Andrew Brest, usually behind the wheel of an Outlaw Super Late Model, drove a Template Late Model to a fast time of 13.998. In the Outlaw Super Late Models, 2009 Kalamazoo Klash winner Steve Needles put up a 13.065.

Grandstand tickets for the Friday, April 30 Season Opener go on sale at the Kalamazoo Speedway ticket office at 3:30 PM on race day. The pits open at 3:30, qualifying begins at 5:20 and racing starts at 7:30 PM.
