RESERVED SEATING is located on the large deck in Turn 3. Your individual seat, with room to walk around, will be waiting for you whether you arrive at 3 PM for hot laps or 7:30 PM just in time to catch the racing action. Call the Speedway Office at (269) 355-4628 to reserve seat(s) with either a credit or debit card. Any seats remaining on race day will be sold at the ticket windows.

Kalamazoo Speedway allows **COOLERS** that do not exceed 14" in size. No glass.

Anyone under the age of 18 must sign in with a parent or legal guardian (no exceptions) when purchasing a **PIT PASS**.

Qualifying - The fastest 20 qualifiers will be locked into the race.

Position 21 - If the Last Chance race winner elects to forfeit their Last Chance pay, they may elect to start at the tail of the 'A' Feature.

Inversion - The inversion will be six plus the roll of two dice; this will make the inversion between 8-18. The inversion for the Last Chance races will be 2 plus the roll of one dice, making the inversion between 4-8.

Race Format/Rules Kalamazoo Klash XXVIII & Raber's Street Stock Rumble

-  The 2021 Kalamazoo Speedway rules for the Outlaw Super Late Models and Street Stock apply.
-  All Klash teams will use the Hoosier F-70 (\$508 a set) for qualifying and racing. **All teams will start the race on the same 4 tires they used to qualify.** All tires must be purchased at the track. Marked tires will be released from impound according to the time listed on the Event Schedule. Drivers will have a 10-minute scuff session at 6:00 PM and immediately proceed to the make-ready chute for qualifying. Any driver returning to their pit stall will lose one of their three laps of qualifying.

All Rumble teams will use the Hoosier 800 series (\$468 a set) for qualifying and racing. **All teams will start the race on the same 4 tires they used to quality.** A limited selection of tires will be available for purchase at the track. Teams may bring in their own unmounted, new 800 series tires. Tires not purchased at the track must be brought to the tire barn where they will be inspected, marked and impounded until the time listed on the Event Schedule.
-  No mirrors. No traction control. No radios. RACEceivers are mandatory. Transponders provided by Kalamazoo Speedway; all cars must have a protective pouch. Pouches will be available for purchase for drivers who need one; plastic brackets are not acceptable.
-  The qualifying order for the Klash will be the determined by the speeds in both Klash practice sessions. The slowest car in the final practice will qualify first, while the fastest car in the final practice session will qualify last. If any car does not qualify in the position in which they are scheduled, they will lose one lap of qualifying. If there is a tie in qualifying, the tie breaker will be a coin flip (2 drivers) or blind draw (3 or more drivers).

- ✿ There will be two group qualifying sessions for Raber's Rumble. Each driver's fastest lap will be considered their qualifying time. If there is a tie in qualifying, the tie breaker will be a coin flip (2 drivers) or blind draw (3 or more drivers).
- ✿ The Klash will run 100 laps with no breaks or competition caution. The Rumble will run 50 laps with no breaks or competition caution.
- ✿ The top eligible lapped car at each caution will receive the Lucky Dog Free Pass for each 'A' feature. A car is not eligible to receive the Lucky Dog Free Pass when, in the judgment of the officials:
 - ✿ The car caused the caution;
 - ✿ The car was in the pit area when the caution came out; or,
 - ✿ The car has been penalized with a discretionary call. In the case of a discretionary penalty, it will be made known to the competitor, at the time the discretionary penalty is imposed, that the car will not be eligible to receive the Pass to make up the penalized lap(s). Transferring the Pass will only occur when the first eligible car becomes ineligible to receive the Pass because of a discretionary penalty, because the car pitted under the caution or because the first eligible car is not in competition at the time the yellow flag is displayed. Then the Pass will be transferred to the next eligible car. There will not be a lucky dog on a false start.
- ✿ For the 'A' features, all restarts will be double file. The leader will choose their lane and the second place car will fill the other position on the front row. Starting with 3rd place on back odd numbered positions will line up on the inside and even numbered positions will line up on the outside. In the event there is a car being sent to the tail, a lucky dog and a car coming out of the pits, they will be lined up in that order.
