The Modified Nationals (Mod Wars) move into the venue early (8:00 AM when the pits open) on May 15. Practice and qualifying start at 11:00 AM with racing following at 6:00 PM. Sixty modifieds are expected to compete in this event plus the Street Stock and Zoo Stock will compete in non-point racing. The Modified's Main feature pays \$5,000 to win with the Street Stock 'A' feature paying \$1,000 to win and the Zoo Stock 'A' feature paying \$500 to win. This is a leased event so Grandstand Punch Passes and the replacement tickets from 2020 cannot be used for this event. Skybox tickets and pit pass punch passes may be used as usual.



REMINDERS



Given we didn't race last week, we're repeating reminders from last week.

PETS. Our longstanding policy on pets has changed due to new insurance regulations. No pets are allowed in the grandstand or pit areas. Thank you for your cooperation.

TRANSPONDERS. Pick up your transponder when you purchase your pit pass; if you haven't registered (no charge) through MyRacePass you will be asked to step aside and do so before you are issued your transponder. A few transponder issues have prompted us to remind drivers about mounting transponders:

- I. Transponders are mounted in a transponder pouch – no plastic brackets.
 - a. Transponders must be mounted vertically (the hole is on top); do not mount the transponder horizontally.
 - b. Transponders must be mounted in the rear section of the car close to the center line of the rear tires.
 1. RWD Cars. Transponders are mounted on the rear end housing.
 2. FWD Cars. There can be no pipes or brackets of any kind below the transponder.
2. Transponders are returned to the payout window before payout is issued.



DRIVER REGISTRATION.



Drivers who have registered on MyRacePass for 2021 do not have to register again. If you registered to race at another track, simply open your account and add Kalamazoo Speedway. If you have not completed the registration process at Kalamazoo Speedway or anywhere else, please do so before coming to the track. This information is used for scoring, tax purposes and Speedway publications.

Register right from the Kalamazoo Speedway homepage (www.kalamazospeedway.com). Click on the MyRacePass icon and follow the simple instructions. Thank you.

2020 TICKETS. Handling of the tickets from the 2020 season opener has appeared in Track Talk and other locations numerous times since 2020. If you purchased tickets for the season opener in 2020, were not issued a refund and have not already picked up your replacement tickets, you have replacement tickets waiting for you. While many fans have picked up their tickets at one of the 2021 events, there are a number of you who haven't. Starting with the May 14 race, tickets will be located at the WILL CALL marked window on Kalamazoo Speedway sponsored race nights (this excludes May 15, May 28-29 and August 7). If you picked up your 2020 tickets last year, please bring the tickets with you when you pick up the replacements. Tickets dated July 3, 2020 are void; you must exchange them. While this may be the last time we post a reminder in Track Talk, your tickets will be available until the end of the 2021 season. Replacement tickets are ONLY valid in 2021.
