



Kalamazoo, Michigan (September 11, 2021)

It was Super Shoe Tune Up “Run What Ya Brung” night at Kalamazoo Speedway and 109 cars showed up for a fun night of racing. No more weekly classes, just front wheel drives, or rear wheel drives and the National Compacts Touring Series.

The National Compacts hosted its 8th Annual World Series of Compacts with its \$3,500 purse. In a continuation of Kalamazoo Speedway’s regular season results, Dave Leonard Jr. took fast time (14.980) and then took the checkered flag for the main feature. He was followed across the line by 2021 Outlaw FWD champion Will Slaughter, Jacob Gustafson, Phil Malouf and Ben Wilcox. Chris Elwell picked up the ‘B’ feature win. Series owner, Andy Jach, arranged a 911 remembrance having all 20 of its main feature drivers run 4 wide, each carrying an American flag, for a parade lap.

In the front wheel drives Drew Losey took fast time (15.263) out of the 42 entrants. Mark Gunthorpe won the ‘B’ feature and Matt Brauer captured the ‘A’ feature win. Brauer was followed across the finish line by Drew Losey, Will Slaughter, Matthew Elsey Jr., and Willie Neal. Elsey Jr.’s car sported, quite possibly, the largest boards ever seen on a front wheel drive vehicle.

Andrew Brest took fast time for the rear wheel drive division sporting a modest board set-up (11.900). He and A.J. Foote Jr. (sporting impressive boards) had a two-car speed showdown (a surprise addition). Brest put up an 11.415, while Foote followed with an 11.986. But it was Foote who put it all together to win the ‘A’ feature. Rob Hardy, Rick Senneker, Josh Trammel and Jeff Bozell rounded out the top 5. Caleb Barron won the ‘B’ feature.

On Saturday, September 18, it’s the Legendary Night of Destruction with old favorites like the Bus Races and new Novelty Races. Scarecrow and the Monster Trucks return and we cap off the night with fireworks. Want to avoid the ticket window lines? Call the Speedway to order tickets in advance; both general admission and reserved seating are available. Ticket windows open on September 18 at 9:00 AM, the pits open at 1:00 (only for competitors), monster truck rides and free bus rides begin at 4:30 PM. The program starts at 7:00 PM sharp. Come early!
