

KALAMAZOO SPEEDWAY FAST FACTS

fastest 3/8 mile oval in the world

- ✚ Opened in 1950 – 72 seasons of racing
- ✚ Located off US 131 – 10 minutes from Kalamazoo; 40 minutes south of Grand Rapids
- ✚ Paved 3/8 mile high-banked oval
- ✚ Paved pit space for 145 cars with trailers/haulers
- ✚ Seats 6,500 and includes 43 skyboxes (holding 8–16 guests each)
- ✚ An elevator serves 16 skyboxes along the front stretch
- ✚ Racing April through September
- ✚ Designated alcohol and smoke-free family seating (capacity of over 1,000)
- ✚ Paved accessible parking, modern restrooms and 30 acres of general parking
- ✚ Top of the line safety equipment staffed by paramedics
- ✚ Visiting series include the Midwest Modifieds, Must See Racing Winged Sprints & Midwest Lights, the National Compact Touring Series, MCR Dwarfs and the FASS Big Rigs.
- ✚ Special events include the Red, White & Boom, Kalamazoo Klash, the Legendary Night of Destruction, Super Shoe Nationals, early Spring warm-up events and Fireworks
- ✚ Six unique concession stands, two party decks (capacity of 50-300) plus hospitality services
- ✚ Proud supporter of numerous local non-profit organizations, schools and churches
