When's the last time that three #27 cars finished in the top 10?

Matthew Elsey Jr. set a new class track record now that he wasn't hemmed in by a speed limit. Elsey Jr. graduated from the Zoo Stock during qualifying on April 29 (his third consecutive season to graduate) having won the Zoo Stock A feature on April 23. He also won the September 10 FWD class feature (Super Shoe Tune Up) as well as a heat race (same event). Elsey Jr, was the class Rookie of the Year.

Dave Leonard Jr. won the non-point April 23 feature (the National Compact Touring Series joined the class for that night). He also took fast time in the Zoo Stock class on April 23 and then broke the speed limit in the feature being the first 2022 driver to be bumped from the Zoo Stock.

Will Slaughter finished in the top 5 at the Super Shoe Tune Up (September 10) and also won a heat race (same date) plus won the NCTS feature at the American Speed US Nationals leased event.

Matt Elsey placed in the top 5 for the April 23 race and won the B feature for the FWD's at Super Shoe.

Kenny Wright organized the Dare to Be Different Race for Autism on April 23.

Dan Rigoni won the championship in 2016.
