## Kalamazoo Speedway Power Wheels Balloon Derby

In front of the grandstands during the pit party at 5:00 PM. Come watch the kids compete like the big people do!

## **Rules:**

- 1. Any regular electric power wheel is allowed, no 4-wheeler type vehicles allowed.
- 2. Child's legs must be in a compartment. Ride in, not ride on.
- 3. Kids 3-8 years old may participate. If we have enough interest, we will split up the 3,4 and 5-year olds from the 6,7 and 8-year olds.
- 4. Helmets MUST be worn.
- 5. The vehicle is allowed up to a 12-volt lawn mower battery which cannot be mounted in the passenger seat and the battery must be secured and sealed away from the child.
- 6. All doors and tailgates must be strapped shut. No sharp edges. Use zip ties, duct tape or other flexible products for making them stay shut.
- 7. Tires may be covered in duct tape to prevent them from breaking. NOTHING ELSE MAY BE ADDED.
- 8. Motor must remain stock. The only modification you may use and will be allowed is using a lawn mower battery.
- 9. Decorative changes can be made to the power wheel to make it look like a derby car. However, there can be no reinforcement to the power wheel. Changes and additions are only decorative. Examples: Header pipes sticking up, painting the car, etc.
- 10. Always remember that this is for the kids! Don't add something that could cause them not to be in the derby. You could have a very disappointed child if they are not allowed to run.
- 11. You will add balloons tied to the bumper and the sides of the body at wheel level or level with the bumpers.
- 12. This event is free for your child to participate in.
- 13. You are responsible to pay admission to the Night of Destruction.
