
Come join us for a weekend of racing and a great time at Super Shoe XXXVI!!!

DRIFTING FESTIVAL (LEASED EVENT) RECAP

Over 24 hours of open drifting! Music. Camping. Good company. A very good time! Spectators were treated to a group of drivers who were captivating. Drifting under the lights was a different touch. Spectators were able to upgrade their \$5 grandstand ticket to a \$20 pit pass and talk to the drivers who are always happy to talk about their car and their sport—and offer ride-a-longs.
