## **APRIL 6, 2024: KALAMAZOO TRACK SERVICES TRAINING.**

Kalamazoo Track Services (KTS) will be holding a training on Saturday, April 6 in the track infield from 2:00 – 4:00 PM. The grandstands will be open for anyone who'd like to check it out. Be warned, bathrooms are not open due to the cold and not being able to turn the water on. On the agenda are practicing for such things as basic extrication, wrecker operations and possibly Flip R car training. Sorry, no spectators allowed in the pits on Saturday.

# **APRIL 12, 2024: OPEN PRACTICE.**

The season kicks off with an open practice on Friday, April 12. The pits open at 3:30 PM (please have your driver MRP registration completed no later than April 11 if you plan to practice). Adult pit passes are \$20, junior pit passes are \$10 and the grandstands are FREE! Testing begins at 5:30 and we'll go until 9:00 PM or until no more cars want to hit the track, whichever comes first.

Season Opener number 74! Don't miss it. The four weekly classes make their first appearances of the season: the AFC Metal Supply Late Models, the Honor Credit Union Outlaw Limited Late Models and the Techworks Trailer Street Stock are the rear wheel drive classes. The Front Wheel Drives are now one class with two divisions: the O'Reilly Auto Parts FWD - Outlaws running on Hoosier tires and the FWD - DOT division running on street tires. Each division will crown a champion. On tap on April 19 is the 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Dare to be Different Race for Autism racing for \$1,000 to win in the 'A' feature and \$150 to start.

The FWD Hoosier racers will also boast a \$150 to start 'A' feature and a \$1,000 to win purse.



The Late Model feature will pay \$1,500 to win and the remainder of the RWD classes will pay \$1,000 to win the 'A' features.

Drivers (and fans) will notice that the finish line is now about 25 feet earlier than it has been for the last 30 plus years. With all the pavement that had to be removed to install underground conduit for the new lighting and PA systems, this seemed like the ideal time to address a scoring nightmare. Now, cars exiting the pits will not trip the scoring loop, which in years past gave a driver doing a fast pit under green or caution a one lap advantage (pitting did not put them a lap down). Although everyone was treated the same, the improvements provided an excellent opportunity to correct a longstanding unfair advantage.


