Camping Rules & information

Diagrams of the camping areas may be found on the Speedway website by clicking on the Super Shoe post on the home page. Camping reservation requests may be texted or emailed (269.355.4628 or barbara@kalamazoospeedway.com). Campers wanting to reserve their 2024 campsites have until Thursday, September 4 to do so; after this date the campsites will be available for others to book. All other advance reservation requests will be accepted through 5:00 pm on September 22. We will do our best to honor requests as submitted and when this isn't possible, we'll work with you to find a campsite you're happy with. After September 22, any remaining campsites may be reserved at the track on a walk-in basis beginning at 4:00 PM on Wednesday, September 24. There is a camping pass/clean-up fee per campsite of \$60. Campsites are not fully reserved until payment is received.

All campsites measure approximately 20' x 40'. Only one camper per campsite is permitted; however, if you are part of a group with adjoining campsites, you may arrange the campers however you wish in the overall reserved space. Please do not reserve more space than you will actually need.

All campsites are marked and numbered on a master grid; staff are available to assist you in finding your site.

Homestead signs (name & a contact number) must be posted on your campsite(s).

Campers may be parked beginning at 4:00 PM on Wednesday, September 24. No campers may be parked in advance of this time without specific advance approval. (269.355.4628)

- The Camping Pass/Clean-up fee is \$60 per campsite for the race weekend.
- Anyone sleeping in their enclosed car trailer will need a camping pass for that trailer. Other car trailers or haulers may not be parked in campsites.
- GOLF CARTS ONLY. No ATV's, scooters, tractors, lawn mowers, mini bikes, quads, side by sides, three wheelers, etc. All golf carts must be parked at midnight each night. If you are caught driving too fast or carelessly or after curfew, a Speedway Official has the right to impound your golf cart for the remainder of the weekend or you may load it up and remove it from Speedway property. No drivers under the age of 12 will be allowed to drive a golf cart; no driving over 10 MPH. Call Westview Golf Carts (269.720.7168) to rent.
- Super Shoe XXXVIII will be an awesome weekend but there are rules that must be followed to keep this event safe and trouble-free. The Kalamazoo County Sheriff's Department and Alamo Fire & Rescue will be patrolling to keep an eye on fire lanes, excessively sized camp fires, excessive partying and unruly behavior.
- The Kalamazoo Speedway staff and the Kalamazoo County Sheriff's Department have the right to have you escorted off the property for Super Shoe Weekend for rule infractions. Absolutely NO fighting, illegal substances, smoking of recreational pot, guns, weapons or under-aged alcohol consumption will be tolerated or allowed on Kalamazoo Speedway property.
