Big Car Enduro Rules

Eligible Vehicles – Rear-wheel-drive 6- or 8-cylinder cars, trucks, or SUVs with full frames. Engines must be to the make and model. No supercharged or turbocharged engines. No AWD vehicles. Stock means stock. Old-school or former Enduro cars are encouraged!

Wheels and Tires – Must be stock for the vehicle. No racing rims or high-performance tires. DOT tires only.

Interior and Glass – Interior may remain in the car. All glass must be removed except for the windshield. If the windshield is removed, a minimum of three bars with screen must be mounted in front of the driver. All headlights and taillights must be removed.

Suspension – Must remain stock.

Bumpers – Must remain stock for the make and model of the vehicle. No large tubing, channel, I-beam, or overbuilt bumpers allowed. Great Lakes Racing Promotions officials' decisions are final.

Body – Basic trimming of the body is allowed. No sharp edges.

Seat and Belts – Racing seat and belts are highly recommended, but stock seat and belts are permitted.

Driver's Door – Must be securely fastened shut by welding, chaining, or wiring. Driver's door protection is mandatory—a plate must be installed on the inside or outside of the door. Roll bar tubing is allowed. If door protection is mounted on the outside, it must stay basically flush with the body. A 4-point roll cage is recommended but not required.

Safety Gear – Fire suit recommended but not required. If not worn, long pants, long-sleeve shirt, closed-toe shoes, and gloves are mandatory. Helmet is required. Neck protection is highly recommended.

Passengers - No passengers allowed.
