STATS. We saw 518 drivers racing at Kalamazoo Speedway in 2018. That's 9 fewer than in 2017; not too shabby given we tied the all-time record for washouts (there were also 7 washouts in 2015). Of the 518, 293 drivers earned points. That's 100 more drivers earning points in 2018 as earned points in 2017. Thirty-six drivers earned points in more than one class.
