Raber's Rumble Format

- Kalamazoo Speedway will have plenty of tires available at the track for \$112 each (includes mounting & sales tax). Teams planning to qualify or race on tires not purchased from the track on the day of the event will be responsible for bringing all racing and qualifying tires to the tire impound area of the infield at least 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying. All tires will be checked, and broken down as needed, and then marked. No car will be allowed to go out for hot laps (which is your group qualifying session) with any tires not marked by the track. If a driver is caught on the track with unmarked tires, the driver's qualifying time for that qualifying session will not be allowed. Teams not purchasing tires from the track on the day of the event need to get to the track early enough to get tires marked.
- There will be two group qualifying sessions.
- Each driver's fastest lap will be considered their qualifying time.
- If there is a tie in qualifying, the tie breaker will be a coin flip between the two drivers.
- The Dash for Cash line up will be a full inversion of the fastest lap times turned by each car from the Odd/Even features.
- Cars qualifying 45th and back will be fully inverted in the Consolation race.
- All restarts will be double-file Madhouse style.
- The inversion for the Odd/Even features will be as follows:
 - Roll #1 (Inversion 16)
 - Roll #2 (Inversion 17)
 - Roll #3 (Inversion 18)
 - Roll #4 (Inversion 19)
 - Roll #5 (Inversion 20)
 - Roll #6 (Inversion 22)

This is a non-points event.
