

Frequently Asked Questions

1. **Can I buy tickets ahead of time or do I have to wait until the day of the event?**
You may purchase tickets by phone (269.355.4628) with a credit card (through Thursday at 7:00 PM) and pick them up beginning at 10:00 AM on July 2 when the tickets windows open at the track.
2. **Can I buy tickets online?**
Kalamazoo Speedway does not sell tickets online at present.
3. **What does this year's program look like?**

4. **How do I sign up to run in one of the races?**
Please send an e-mail to barbara@kalamazoospeedway.com. You may also just show up.
5. **Can I bring in a cooler?**
Guests may bring in a cooler that measures 14" or smaller. NO GLASS.
6. **What if I buy a ticket and the event is cancelled for some reason?**
The ticket becomes a raincheck and may be used at another Kalamazoo Speedway sponsored event, including the Night of Destruction in September. There are no cash refunds.
7. **Are you having fireworks?**
We sure are and we think the display will be the most spectacular in the area.
8. **Are your concession stands open?**
Concession stands are open; some of the stands only take cash.
9. **Are you selling pit passes for Friday?**
Only drivers and essential crew are allowed in the pits for this event. Drivers and crew will purchase their pit passes at the pit gate, not the ticket window.
10. **When can I put a blanket down to save seats?**
Putting down blankets or other seat markers can be placed starting when the ticket windows open at 10:00 AM on Friday, July 2. Seat savers placed before then will be removed.
11. **Are there any skyboxes left for July 2?**
We are sold out for July 2; boxes are still available for July 3.
