Bandit Big Rig Series - Cancels event at Kalamazoo Speedway

Blooming Prairie, MN - The most exciting race series on oval tracks has made the tough decision to cancel their event slated for August 7th at Kalamazoo Speedway. Due to continued business issues with the big rig series, the decision was made to move the event until a future date.

Jason Johnson, GM of the Bandit Big Rig Series, noted his displeasure as the excitement for a return to the ZOO since their inaugural 2019 race has grown. "Kalamazoo Speedway is an A+ facility, to have the opportunity to race on the home track of the *Klash* is one of those on the schedule that was a can't wait, as it was a must do with the race teams to come back and battle on the famed 3/8-mile track," said Johnson. With issues that arose in late May and have continued, the race slated for August 7th became a serious issue and has been in jeopardy of not happening since. With unclear answers still to the issues, the only fair thing to do for the fans who have this event circled on their calendar was to make the tough decision that the race in August would have to be cancelled. "It's never easy, especially with so many things in place, a lot of fan buildup and of course the weekend hotspot for action, Kalamazoo is one event that hurts to not be putting on, it's for sure something we wished we'd not have to be doing" Johnson stated. Bandit Big Rig Series does hope to schedule a future date and get back over to Kalamazoo Speedway sometime in the future.
