

MAY 13. 2022 * RACE RECAP



It was a hot one at Kalamazoo Speedway both in terms of racing and weather. The Midwest Modifieds Tour was the headliner for the night. Walt Obrinske Jr. was the fast qualifier with a time of 13.690. Jeff Ganus (left) made it two in a row by winning the 50-lap feature in the 24-car field. (Readers may recall that Ganus spent the final practice during last year's event replacing his engine.) Greg Fullarton led the race for about 20 laps before giving it up to Jason Timmerman. Ganus powered his way to the lead with 17 laps remaining. Walt Obrinske Jr. was the runner-up

followed by Matt Dimit, Greg Fullarton and Jason Timmerman rounding out the top five. The second half of the order ran Tom Rutherford, Bud Adams, Nic Weimer, Bubba Brooks and Buddy Gray.

In the Spartan Insulation Zoo Stock, Tod Watson drove to fast time (16.785) outpacing the 36 car field. Ira Hosner, Drew Hosner, Tim Gale and Michael Metheny won the heat races. For the second week in a row, the Zoo Stock 'B' feature upstaged the 'A' feature. Tim Gale (below right) followed his heat race victory with a 20-lap 'B' feature win, running nearly half the race with a flat tire. Gale was running in second place when the tire started sending out help-me smoke signals with 9 laps remaining. Gale shot out to

the lead with 6 laps remaining and despite the odds, continued to outpace the

field and cross the finish line.

The Zoo Stock 'A' feature was peppered with cautions (in an otherwise rather caution free evening), eventually being called for time when a caution was thrown with three laps remaining of the 25-lap feature. Tod Watson carried the speed from qualifying into the feature only to dip under the maximum allowable speed permitted in the Zoo Stock (16.750) and was disqualified. That handed the win to Ryan Diamond (bottom right) (0.008 from being disqualified himself). Logan Meade put in about 10 laps at the front of the pack and finished second, followed by Keith Dixon, Drew Hosner and Duane Green II. Eric Mepyans, Scott Elsey, Ira Hosner, Keegan Letts and Jimmy Hammann comprised the top 10.

Austin Maynard, fresh off his opening night win in the Techworks Trailer Sales Street Stock, took fast time (14.647) then made it two in a row with the 35-lap feature win out of the field of 20. Josh Zordan and Bill Waldon won the heat races. Keith Wilfong took the early lead in the feature before Maynard (below) passed him with 19







remaining. Brandon Zachary made a run for the lead but fell short in the end. At the checkered flag it was former 2019 track champion Brandon Zachary, Keith Wilfong, Josh Zordan and Jeremy Young completing the top five. The second half of the order ran Colin Bozell, Heath Bronkema, Gage Harris, Alex Sexton and Ricky LaDuke.
