For the winged sprint car enthusiasts, the Winged Sprints (410 Series) will be racing on both May 27 and May 28. The Midwest Lights will be racing on May 27. Kalamazoo Speedway's own Zoo Stock will be racing for points on May 27 and the National Compact Touring Series will be racing both days. On Saturday, the Ohio Wheelman (Street Stock) will be joining the program as will the always entertaining MCR dwarfs. What's not to like?

Equally impressive is that Steadfast for Veterans will be honoring veterans. The event will honor the longstanding practice of

discounting admission tickets for veterans and has a plethora of activities designed to honor and thank veterans for their service. A WWII Warbird flyover performed by the Hooligan Flight Team is on tap. The Vietnam era Huey Helicopter that was to be on display, and for the brave at heart to hitch a ride, is

Left. Taylor Sexton (4th in the Street Stock and racing in each point race) and Alex Sexton (right). Alex Sexton missed only one race and finished 6th in the final standings; he was the Street Stock Rookie of the Year.
